



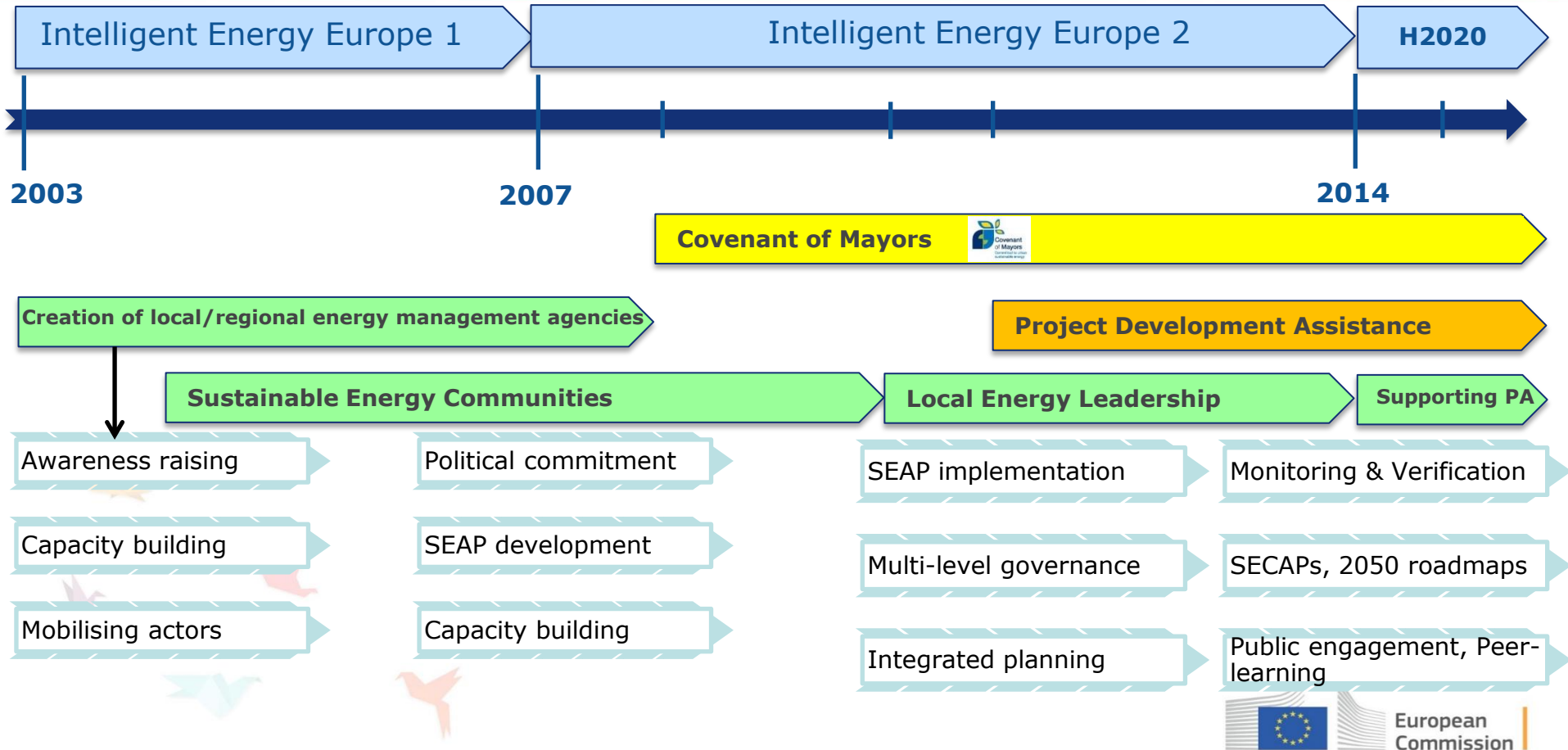

IEE support to cities and regions in a nutshell

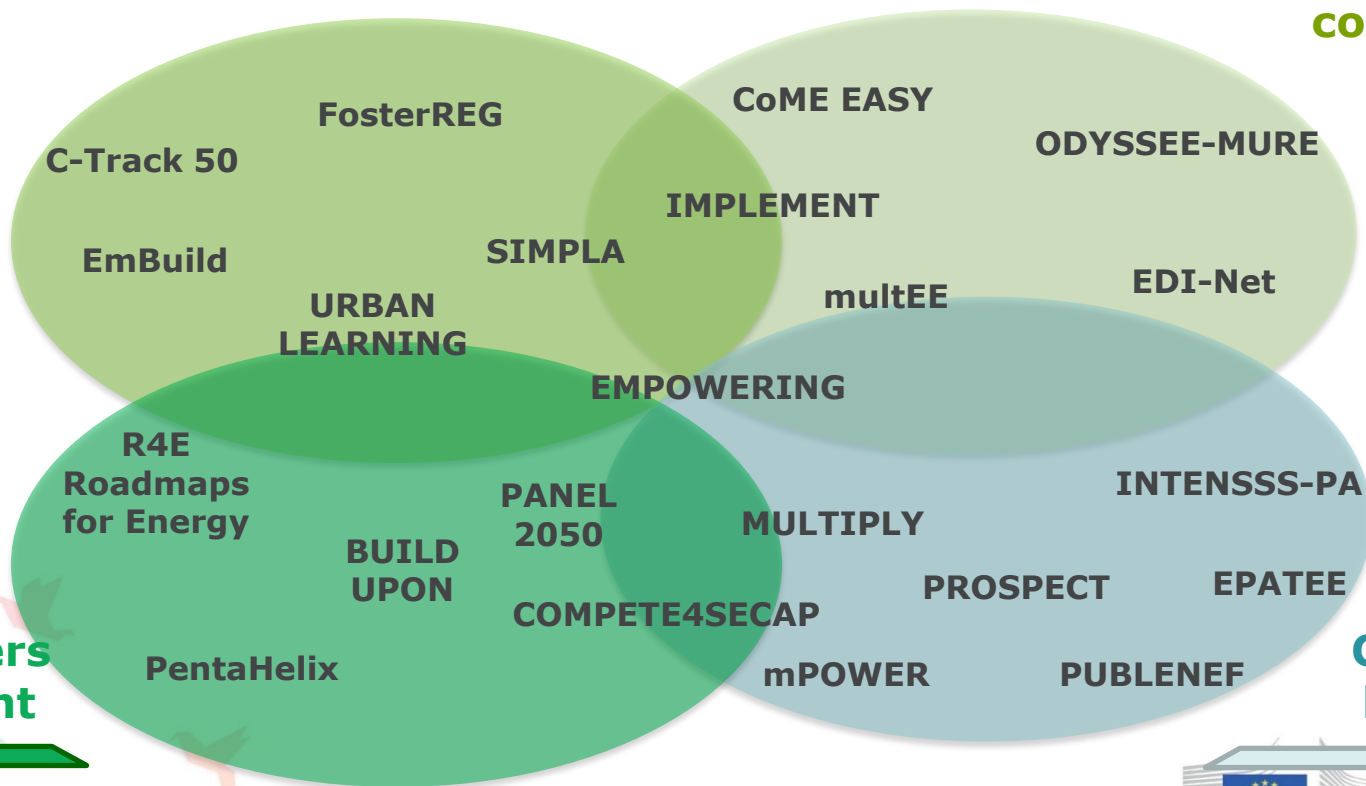
- **EU 39 million (2007-2013) for 34 projects** supporting sustainable energy communities
- 351 beneficiaries
- 800 public authorities supported
- >500 **Sustainable Energy Actions Plans** created
- **79 new energy agencies** established (2003-2013)

EMPOWERING Project



- Fosters exchange of experience between 6 European **regions**
- Develops a **multidisciplinary transnational** and **local learning** process, based on initial capacity-building needs analysis
- Involves municipalities, regions, local stakeholders and **managing authorities of EU Structural Funds**
- Establishment of **Local Energy Boards** in each region
- Exploit **synergies** with Life SEC Adapt project in Marche and Istria regions

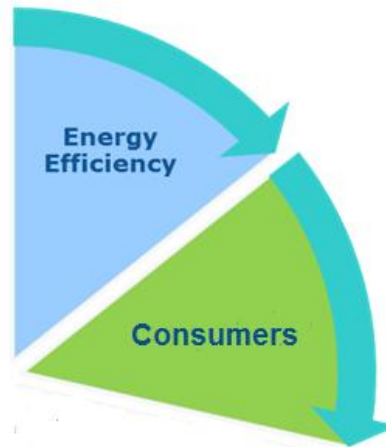

EE16 – Supporting public authorities to implement the Energy Union

Scope a) Support to local and regional public authorities

Enhanced **monitoring and verification** of EE measures and better coordination of administrative levels

Development of **transition roadmaps** with a long-term time horizon (**2050**) to inform development /implementation of **SEAPs/SECAPs** and similar plans

Innovative public engagement of public authorities with civil society

Large-scale and action-oriented **peer-to-peer learning programmes** for cities and/or regions

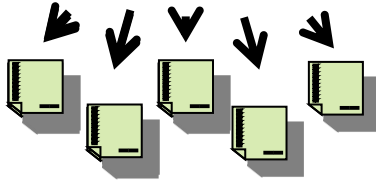
Scope b) Delivery of the Energy Efficiency Directive

EE11 – Project Development Assistance

- **Build** technical, economic and legal **expertise** needed for project development
- **Remove** legal, administrative and other market **barriers**
- **Aggregate** (pooling, bundling) **projects** to reach critical size
- **Mobilize private finance**
- **Investments launched** before end of the action!
- **1:15 leverage ratio**
- **Proposals from 1 single entity are eligible** - EU contribution 100%
- **38 projects funded so far** >780 M€ investments

EE17 – City Facility in a nutshell

- **Financial support and services to municipalities** (or groupings)
- **Via** simplified “**cascade funding**”
(max. lump sum: EUR 60,000)



Mobilisation of investments

(incl. combination with EFSI, ESIF, PDA, investment platforms)

- **Develop** solid and innovative **investment concepts**
 - Project pipeline with critical investment scale
 - Financing strategy and process to launch investments
 - Legal and governance analysis

Covenant of Mayors Investments Forum - Energy Efficiency Finance Market Place

- Objective: discuss **planning** and **financing** climate **adaptation** and **mitigation**, clean urban **transport** and **energy efficiency**

- **Thematic parallel strands** of interactive workshops on:
